**Anne Cimballa, an art teacher for grades 7, 9, and 10 at the Charleston County School of the Arts received the 2010 Mary Whyte Art Educator Award and the \$1,000 cash prize that accompanies the award. Established in 2007, the Mary Whyte Art Educator Award is designed to recognize a high school visual art teacher in the tri-county area who has demonstrated superior commitment to his or her students and craft.**

**Ms. Cimballa submitted the lesson plan “Palette Knife Painting,” inspired by the Works of Brian Rutenberg. Students visited the Gibbes exhibition *Brian Rutenberg: Tidesong* and created original landscape paintings using their own photos of the Lowcountry while painting with palette knives in the style of Rutenberg.**
